





## The Five Paragraph Essay

- 1. Paragraph one introduces the reader to the topic. You want to tell your reader what the topic is, but you also want to grab the reader's attention. Don't write: "I am going to write about bla, bla, bla..." Start with something exciting. It can be a freaky fact or a strange experience you've had. After that, you should write three sentences that say something more about your topic and support your viewpoint. These will be your three subtopics.
- In paragraph two, you take the theme of subtopic one and add at least three sentences with details supporting your viewpoint. Make sure you start with a linking word or phrase so you connect the paragraph with the previous one.
- 3. In paragraph three, you take the theme of subtopic two and add at least three sentences with details supporting your viewpoint. Make sure you start off with a linking word or phrase to connect the paragraph with the previous one.
- 4. In paragraph four, you take the theme of **subtopic three** and add at least three sentences with details supporting your viewpoint. Make sure you start off with a linking word or phrase to connect the paragraph with the previous one.
- 5. Paragraph five is your conclusion. Don't introduce anything new! Get back to the theme of your first paragraph and repeat the theme of the three subtopics. Try to make your last sentence stick in the mind of your reader.

## Five-paragraph essay



"Hamburger essay"

Everyone has something important to say about different topics, but there is a difference between chatting with friends and writing an opinion essay. When writing an essay you need to organize your thoughts. All essays have three parts – an Introduction (paragraph 1), a Body (paragraphs 2-4) and a Conclusion (paragraph 5). The "Hamburger essay" pattern helps you get a clear structure for your essay.

#### Paragraph 1: INTRODUCTION

- Try to grab the reader's attention
- Present general information about your topic
- State the issue you are going to discuss

#### Paragraph 2: BODY (first point)

- Present the first point
- Give details and examples to support your point (arguments for or against)

#### Paragraph 3: BODY (second point)

- · Present the second point
- Give details and examples to support your point (arguments for or against)

#### Paragraph 4: BODY (third point)

- · Present the third point
- Give details and examples to support your point (arguments for or against)

#### Paragraph 5: CONLUSION

- Sum up the main message of the essay
- Write a sentence or two that will leave your reader thinking about your topic
